

## **SKI TOUR TO NEW HAMPSHIRE - FEBRUARY 2017 FOR OUR CURRENT YEAR 8 AND 9 PUPILS ONLY**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Arrangements have been made for a ski tour to New Hampshire in the USA. The tour will leave on Saturday 11th February 2017 and return one week later.

The ski tour will take place during the February half term break (11th - 18th Feb). The tour operator we have chosen is Topflight who have an excellent track record in organising ski tours for schools. This year's price is £110 less than last year because the Southern Irish schools do not share our half term dates and the fuel surcharge from Aer Lingus has now been absorbed into the total cost.

**The cost of the ski tour this year will be £1080.**

This includes:

return flights to Boston from Dublin;  
all airport taxes;  
coach transfers to and from Dublin Airport;  
all resort transfers;  
six nights half board accommodation;  
5 day lift pass;  
4 hours of ski lessons per day;  
hire of ski equipment (skis, boots, poles and helmets);  
evening activities, e.g. cinema and last day visit to Boston;  
comprehensive insurance cover; and  
a contribution towards staff cover.

Additional Costs:

You will have to pay ESTA Homeland Security costs (visa). This is approximately £10 and is paid directly to the US government when you register your child's passport online. Further details will be given on this at a later date.

If you wish your child to join the February 2017 ski tour, please indicate your agreement on the attached slip after reading the enclosed medical declaration concerning the insurance cover. Please note that places are very limited and will only be available to our current Year 8 and 9 pupils (those who have not skied with us before will be given preference if too many apply for places. Extras will be placed on a waiting list). **All applications are accepted provisionally and the school reserves the right not to accept applications from pupils whose *record of conduct or academic progress is poor*. Pupils who subsequently fall into this category may be withdrawn from the tour at any time with no refund of deposits paid.**

## **MEDICAL DECLARATION** (from Topflight)

If **you** are under 16 years of age on the date of departure and traveling outside Europe to a Worldwide destination, **you** need to tell **us** of anything that is likely to affect our acceptance of your cover.

In order that **we** can ensure **you** are provided with the best cover we can offer please read the following questions carefully:

- a) Have you ever had treatment for -
- A heart or circulatory condition,
  - A stroke or high blood pressure,
  - A breathing condition (such as asthma),
  - Any type of cancer,
  - Any type of diabetes,
  - Any psychological condition (such as stress, anxiety or depression)?
- b) Have you seen your GP or been referred to a hospital or specialist consultant for a health condition that has;
- Been diagnosed within the last 12 months,
  - Been in existence in the last 12 months,
  - Resulted in treatment being given in the last 12 months?

If **you** have answered “Yes” to any of the above **you** must declare this to the group organiser who will contact the insurance company to find out if cover can be granted.



## BOOKING FORM

I have read the Terms and Conditions of the visit as described in the letter and medical declaration, and agree to be bound by them and agree to pay the total cost of £1080.

An **initial deposit of £150** should be sent with this reply slip. Places are allocated on a first come first served basis. **A further £150 deposit** is required by the tour company and should be in school no later than **Friday 8th April 2016**. The balance of the **full amount** is then due no later than the **Friday 4th November 2016**. A full schedule of payments will be sent out at a later date.

**[Please note that the initial deposits (£300) are non-refundable once they have been forwarded to the tour company (as they are passed directly to the airline to secure seats) unless a medical claim, covered by the insurance company, is valid].**
